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The Financial Reality

Without a long-term funding solution, RTC could face a projected annual shortfall of **\$118.5 million** and may need to reduce up to **42% of bus service as early as 2028**. That means fewer routes, longer waits and reduced access to jobs, healthcare, and essential services..
